#### **ALL FORMS MUST BE RETURNED TO THE OFFICE**

**NO LATER THAN 3 (three) *business days***

**BEFORE your child's appointment.**

(ie; appointment is on Monday, the forms need to be in the office **by the morning** of the previous Wednesday)

If the forms are not returned 3 days before your child's appointment, the appointment will be cancelled and rescheduled to a later date. *Should that happen, your child's prescription will not be refilled until they have their appointment.*
